

Make a Book Tea T-shirt

- 1) Take a plain t-shirt of any color and turn it into an advertisement/explanation of your book.
- 2) Include the following elements on your shirt:
 - a. Book title
 - b. Author
 - c. One favorite quote from the book
 - d. A one-sentence statement of the main idea/theme of the book
 - e. Front of the shirt has to have image(s) that represent a major event or idea in the book
 - f. Include details and/or other symbols that represent ideas from the book so that little/no blank space should be left on the shirt

*With the exception of the theme, the above items do not have to be written in complete sentences.

**You may use any medium to make your shirt—markers, paint, iron-ons, sewn-on or pinned on or hot glued items. You can manipulate the shirt however you need to in order to communicate your ideas about the book.

Content of shirt	Did not do the assignment or so much of the elements a.-f. are missing that it is unclear what this person read. Presentation of shirt	Did not to the assignment or it was clear the student did not put any thought into the assignment.	T-shirt has a lot of blank space so that it seems like the shirt was not planned well. Or shirt looks "very busy" so that it appears as if the student just filled in space without thinking.	T-shirt displays elements of design that show some thought, creativity, and/or originality. May be slightly messy or have items placed in a haphazard way.	T-shirt is attractively designed. Student clearly applied thought, creativity, and originality. Student is clearly proud to wear his/her work.
